

## Operating Golf Carts on Public Roadways

## Dear City of Wrens Residents:

The City has received several recent complaints regarding the unsafe operation of golf carts on City roadways. Please note the following rules and requirements for operating golf carts on public roadways in the City:

## Required Equipment:

- (1) A braking system sufficient for the weight and passenger capacity of the vehicle including a parking brake;
- (2) A reverse warning device;
- (3) A main power switch. When the switch is in the "off" position the golf cart shall be inoperative. If the switch uses a key, it shall only be removable in the "off" position;
- (4) Head lamps;
- (5) Reflex reflectors;
- (6) Tail lamps;
- (7) A horn;
- (8) A rearview mirror;
- (9) Safety warning labels; and
- (10) Hip restraints and hand holds or a combination thereof.

## Operating Standards:

- (1) Operator must have a valid driver's license;
- (2) Golf Cart must be insured;
- (3) Golf Carts may not be operated on State Routes.
